THAT WE THE CHIEF AND COUNCIL OF ST. MARY'S BAND PASS THIS DATE  
THE FOLLOWING BY-LAW UNDER SECTION 81, SUBSECTION (E IN PART) A BY-LAW.

1. Not permitting the keeping of domestic animals on the Reserve particularly the residential area and in particular cattle, goats, horses, sheep, mules, chickens, turkey or any farm baring animal
2. Unless properly zoned all areas shall be classed as residential
3. Fine shall dispose of any such animal found in any area unless otherwise classed as farm or commercial areas within Reserve boundaries now properly marked
4. Failing to comply with paragraph 3 will result in the following:
  - (A) fine of \$50.00
  - (B) fine of \$50.00 plus destruction of animals
  - (C) \$50.00 fine, destruction of animals or imprisonment of five days.
