

Mohawk Council of Kahnawake
By-Law No. T.B.L. CIR 1A

Being a by-law to amend by-law #T.B.L. CIR1
respecting traffic circulation, public
security and nuisances.

WHEREAS the Mohawk Council of Kahnawake passed it's
by-law No. T.B.L. CIR1 on February 24, 1977, respecting the
circulation of traffic, public security, and nuisance on the
Caughnawaga Indian Reserve No. 14, in the Province of Quebec;

AND WHEREAS the Council is of the opinion that the by-law
should be amended to correct certain deficiencies;

NOW THEREFORE the Mohawk Council of Kahnawake makes as
a by-law thereof the following --

1. Article 1(A) of by-law No. T.B.L. CIR1, dated
February 24, 1977, be and the same is hereby
amended by adding the words "or the Kahnawake
Peacekeepers" following the words "Police Force"
in the second line thereof so that the said Article
shall read --

"1 A PEACE OFFICER - includes any member of the
Caughnawaga Police Force or the Kahnawake
Peacekeepers, and special constables appointed
under the Police Act of the Province of Quebec
having jurisdiction on the Caughnawaga Indian
Reserve and any special supernumerary constable
appointed under the Royal Canadian Mounted
Police Act and having jurisdiction on the Caughnawaga
Indian Reserve".

2. By-Law No. T.B.L. CIRI, dated February 24, 1977,
be and the same is hereby amended by deleting
Article 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the
following --

"9-A. SPEED LIMIT IN MOHAWK TERRITORY

No motor vehicle will circulate in the territory
at a speed more than 70 kilometres per hour on
routes 132 and 138, 50 kilometres per hour
on routes 207 and Old Chateauguay Road, 30
kilometres per hour on all roads or streets in
the village, hospital zone, school zone and
other areas as designated.

In the case of a speeding offence, the minimum
fine shall automatically be \$20.00 for the
offence, plus \$1.00 per kilometre past the speed
limit up to 15 kilometres past the speed limit,
from 16 to 25 kilometres the fine shall be
\$20.00 plus an additional \$3.00 for every
kilometre over the speed limit, and from 26
kilometres and up past the speed limit, the
fine shall be \$20.00 plus \$5.00 for every
kilometre past the speed limit."

Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Mohawk
Council of Kahnawake this 20th day of December 1980.
