NOW THEREFORE the Band repeals the following by-laws:

- By-law No. 1, being a by-law to provide controls and A) regulations for the disposal of sewage;
- By-law No. 4, being a by-law respecting the disposal of B) garbage and waste;
- By-law No. 6, being a by-law respecting vacant houses; C) and
- By-law No. 7, being a by-law respecting leaving of houses vacant for certain periods of time. D)
