BY-LAW NO. 2:

Considering that the Micmacs of Maria Band Council has adopted by-law no. 2 on April 27, 1977, according to sub-paragraph, c,b,d, r of Section 81 of the Indian Act.

Considering that the said Council considers this by-law to now be inadequate.

By-law No. 3, adopted to provide for the control and regulation of activities of boys and girls on the Indian Reserve who are actually or under 16 years of age is by the present abrogated.

BY-LAW NO. 2:

Notice is hereby given that the Micmacs of Maria Band Council at a meeting held this 9th. day of January, 1986, do hereby make the following abrogations to this by-law:

ARTICLE 1:

No boy or girl on the said reserve who is 16 years or under shall loiter in any place on the reserve, after 9:30 p.m. in the evening during the school period. And not after 10:30 p.m. during the vacation.

ARTICLE 2:

No boy or girl who is 16 or under shall be in any place of entertainment, street or by-way within the reserve or shall be in the course of returning from any place of entertainment of the said reserve after the hour of 9 and 10 in the evening. Unless he or she is accompanied by his or her parents, or an adult appointed by the parent.

ARTICLE 3:

Anyone found violating these provisions will be escorted home by an Amerindian Police Officer.

ARTICLE 4:

A parent who permits his or her child to violate these provisions shall be guilty of an offence and be liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$50.00 or imprisonment of a term not exceeding 30 days.

ARTICLE 5:

Notwithstanding article 4, any person who will fully permits his or her child to violate these provisions, cannot hold the Amerindian Police ~~and~~ the Band Council responsible for non-performance of duty if accidents or anything else happens to their children and will be processed to the Social Services Department.
