do herfbyresolve: The Council of the Red Bank Band of Indians at a mating held nakes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (a) and ( $r$ ) of section 80 of the Indian Bg-1aw No, Z 2.
A by-las to provide for the disposal of garbage and waste on the Rad Bank Indian Reserye, the Province of New Bmmorisk.
(a) No person shali accumblate or pemit to be fonumitatel upón lands in his possession or deposit or accumalate on the lands in possession of another person angthing which is c may become offensive or injurious to health.
(b) No person shall deposit any desd animal, offal, fish, manue, garoage, fruit, ragatabl night-soil, filth, liquid waste, or anything of a nature which is or may becone ofiensita, prejudicial to health upon or into any highray, streat, road, alley, lane, lot, ditch, wha dock, lake, pond, river, stream, well, or sewer, or into any land or premises within the reserve and any such deposit shall be deemed a nuisance, provided, however, that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to the deposit and proper disposal of any sue material or at a place within the reserve approved by the council for that purpose.
(c) The Council may arrange for the regular remoral of garbage and waste from any prean sess utinin the reseme.
(d) In the eppring of each year as soon as the molting of snow permits the person in possess of any premises within the reserve shall collect all waste matter liging therson inciuding tin cans, bottles, paper and aniagl manure.
(e) All such waste matter shall be disposed of in such a manner as will provent any muian or offence as the fouling of wella and water supply.
(i) Any person who riolates any of the proviaions of this by-law shall be guilty or an offence and shall be liable on sumbey conviction to a fine not axceeding tan dollars or imprisonment for a tbrm not exceeding seven days, or both tine and imprisonment.
