DO HEREBY RESOLVE: The Council of the Sydney Band of Indians at a meeting held August 10th, 1968, makes the following amendments to By-Law No. 2 pursuant to paragraphs (c), (d), (q), (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act.

- A) No boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 13 years of age, shall loiter any place within the said Indian Reserve after 7:30 p.m. Sunday to Thursday from September 3 to June 21 inclusive in any year.  
Any child between the ages of 14-15 must be in his or her own home by 9:00 p.m. Sunday to Thursday.
- B) No boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 13 years of age, shall be in any place of entertainment, street, lane, by-way or common within the said Reserve, or shall be in the course of returning from any place of entertainment of the said Reserve after the hour of 7:30 p.m.; or any child between the ages of 14-15 after the hour of 9 p.m. unless accompanied by his or her parent or an adult appointed by a parent to accompany such child.
- C) No boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age, shall loiter any place within the said Indian Reserve after 10 p.m. in the evening from June 21 to September 3 inclusive in any year.
- D) No boy or girl on the Sydney Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age, shall be in any place of entertainment, street, lane, by-way or common within the said Reserve, or shall be in the course of returning from any place of entertainment off the said Reserve after the hour of 10 p.m. in the evening from June 21 to September 3 inclusive in any year, unless accompanied by his or her parent or an adult appointed by a parent to accompany the child.
- E) A boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve found violating the provisions of paragraphs (A), (B), (C), (D), may be warned and conducted home by a police officer, a member of the band council, or an appointed officer of the Band Council.

DO HEREBY RESOLVE: The Council of the Sydney Band of Indians at a meeting held August 10th, 1968, makes the following amendments to By-Law No. 2 pursuant to paragraphs (c), (d), (q), (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act.

A) No boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 13 years of age, shall loiter any place within the said Indian Reserve after 7:30 p.m. Sunday to Thursday from September 3 to June 21 inclusive in any year.  
Any child between the ages of 14-15 must be in his or her own home by 9:00 p.m. Sunday to Thursday.

B) No boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 13 years of age, shall be in any place of entertainment, street, lane, by-way or common within the said Reserve, or shall be in the course of returning from any place of entertainment of the said Reserve after the hour of 7:30 p.m.; or any child between the ages of 14-15 after the hour of 9 p.m. unless accompanied by his or her parent or an adult appointed by a parent to accompany such child.

C) No boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age, shall loiter any place within the said Indian Reserve after 10 p.m. in the evening from June 21 to September 3 inclusive in any year.

D) No boy or girl on the Sydney Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age, shall be in any place of entertainment, street, lane, by-way or common within the said Reserve, or shall be in the course of returning from any place of entertainment off the said Reserve after the hour of 10 p.m. in the evening from June 21 to September 3 inclusive in any year, unless accompanied by his or her parent or an adult appointed by a parent to accompany the child.

E) A boy or girl on the Sydney Indian Reserve found violating the provisions of paragraphs (A), (B), (C), (D), may be warned and conducted home by a police officer, a member of the band council, or an appointed officer of the Band Council.
