By-Law # 01-73

The Council of the TOBIQUE Band of Indians at a meeting held this 11th day of September, 1973, at TOBIQUE RESERVE make the following by-law pursuant to Paragraph (q) of Section 81 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 01-73

To create Band positions to provide for the employment of staff to conduct the business of the Band Council.

WHEREAS it is necessary to appoint Band employees to interpret and promote the enforcement of all Band By-laws, to carry out the business of the Council as directed by Band Council Resolution and Council Minutes as well as to carry out such other duties as may be assigned by Council.

THEREFORE the Council of the TOBIQUE Band ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT a Band staff is hereby created for the Tobique Band;
2. THAT the Band staff shall consist of such positions as may be established from time to time by Band Council Resolution;
3. THAT the said positions shall be filled by competition advertised in accordance with the policy of the Band Council expressed by Resolution;
4. THAT the incumbents of the said positions shall hold office during the pleasure of and subject to the By-laws of the Band Council;
5. THAT Band staff shall be employed by contract between each employee and the Band Council and that the terms of such contract shall be binding on both parties.
