The Council of the Tobique Band of Indians at a meeting held this 11 day of February, 1980, at Tobique Reserve make the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (h) and (r) of section 81 of the Indian Act.

By-Law No. 7.

For the protection and use of Band owned buildings on Tobique Reserve, in the Province of New Brunswick.

Whereas paragraph (h) and (r) of section 81 of the Indian Act empowers the council of an Indian band to make by-laws respecting---use of buildings, whether owned by the Band or by individual members of the Band and for the imposition of a penalty for any violation of any By-Law made under that section.

And Whereas it is deemed to be expedient for the welfare of the inhabitants of the Reserve and for the good government of the Band to control the use of Band owned Buildings.

Now Therefore the Council of the Tobique Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof the following.

- 1. (a) "Council" means the council as defined in the Indian Act of the Tobique Band of Indians.
 - (b) "Buildings" means buildings used for public purposes such as Band office, School, arts and crafts center and any other such buildings, as well as those buildings designated for family occupancy for which no certificate of possession has been issued to any individual band member.
 - (c) "Reserve" means the tract of land set apart by Her Majesty whitin the definition in the Indian Act for the use and benefit of the Tobique Band of Indians and known as Tobique Indian Reserve.
- 2. No person shall occupy or in any other way interfer with buildings for which no Certificate of Possession has been issued to him(her) unless he(she) has recieved permission in writing to do so, from the Chief and Council.
- 3. No person shall occupy or in any way interfer with the normal carrying on of business in buildings designated by the Chief and Council for <u>PUBLIC PURPOSES</u>.
- 4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days or both Fine and Imprisonment.
