BY LAW NO. 16

Whereas under Section 28 of the Indian Act, only a band member can occupy or use a reserve, or reside, or otherwise exercise rights on a reserve without the authorization of the Minister and/or band council;

Whereas non-band members and non-Indians who occupy or use a reserve or reside or otherwise exercise rights on a reserve without the authorization of the Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development and/or the band council are guilty of trespass upon the reserve and/or are guilty of frequenting the reserve for proscribed purposes,

Now, therefore, the Council of the Restigouche Indian Band in virtue of Section 80 of the Indian Act hereby enacts the following by-law:

1. Without prejudice to the recourse provided by Sections 30 and 31, of the Indian Act, all non-band members and all non-Indians who occupy or use a reserve or reside or otherwise exercise rights on a reserve without the authorization of the Minister and/or the band council shall be considered to be a trespasser and/or a person trespassing on a reserve and/or frequenting the reserve for proscribed purposes within the meaning of the Indian Act.
2. All such trespassers or persons trespassing on a reserve shall be subject to immediate expulsion from the reserve by order of the band council expressed in a resolution naming the person or persons to be expelled and calling upon them to leave the reserve with their family and property immediately and upon receipt of such notice, such persons and/or their family shall leave the reserve with their property.
3. Any person or persons designated by the council and any peace officer or member of the R.C.M.P. may carry out such order on behalf of the council and use such force as may be necessary in the circumstances to cause such expulsion to be effected.
