The Council of the Sturgeon Lake Band of Indians at a meeting held November 2nd, 1959, makes the following Bylaw pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act.

## Bylaw No. 1

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Sturgeon Lake Indian Reserve, in the Province of Alberta.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 25 M.P.H. on any road within the Sturgeon Lake Indian Reserve #154 marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Twenty Five Dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
