DRAFT BYLAW

The Council of the Sturgwon Lake Indian Band, at a duly covend council meeting held this <u>8</u> day of <u>May</u> make the following bylaw pursuant to paragraphs (d) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

BYLAW NO. #3

A bylaw to provide for the prevention of disorderly conduct and nuisances on the <u>STURGEON LAKE INDIAN RESERVE # 154</u> in the Province of Alberta.

- 1. No person who is a Tenant or Joint Tenant or Sub-Tenant or Joint Sub-Tenant of any dwelling house owned by or leased to the Sturgwon Lake Indian Band shall cause or permit any person to cause a disturbance or behave in a rowdy or disorderly manner in or near such dwelling house
 - (a) by fighting, screaming, shouting, swearing, singing, or using insulting language: or
 - (b) by being drunk: or
 - (c) by impeding or molesting other persons.
- 2. No person shall cause a disturbance or behave in a rowdy or disorderly manner in or near any dwelling house owned by or leased by the Sturgeon Lke Indian Band
 - (a) by fighting, screaming, shouting, swearing, singing, or using insulting language; or
 - (b) by being drunk; or
 - (c) by impeding or molesting other persons.
- 3. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable on Summary Conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both fine and imprisonment.
