

O'CHIESE BAND BY-LAW NO. 2-73

SOR/73-293

THE COUNCIL OF THE O'CHIESE BAND OF INDIANS AT A MEETING HELD THIS 13th DAY OF MARCH 1973 MAKE THE FOLLOWING BY-LAWS UNDER PARAGRAPH (d) AND (or) SECTION 81 OF THE INDIAN ACT, REVISED STATUTES OF CANADA 1952 CHAPTER 149 AND AMENDMENTS THERE TO.

1. ANY PERSON WHO

- (a) HAS LIQUOR IN HIS POSSESSION
- (b) IS INTOXICATED

ON THE O'CHIESE RESERVE IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND IS LIABLE ON SUMMARY CONVICTION TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OR TO IMPRISONMENT FOR A TERM NOT EXCEEDING TWO MONTHS OR TO BOTH FINE AND IMPRISONMENT.

- 2. (a) WHENEVER A POLICE OFFICER BELIEVES ON REASONABLE GROUND THAT AN OFFENCE HAS BEEN COMMITTED IN RESPECT TO LIQUOR, HE MAY SEARCH FOR AND SEIZE THOSE GOODS IN RELATION TO WHICH HE BELIEVES THE OFFENCE WAS COMMITTED
  - (b) WHERE A PERSON IS CONVICTED OF AN OFFENCE CONTRARY TO SECTION 1 OF THIS BY-LAW, THE PRESIDING COURT MAY ORDER THE GOODS OF OR IN RELATION TO WHICH THE OFFENCE WAS COMMITTED IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY IMPOSED, ARE FORFEITED TO HER MAJESTY.
3. FINES COLLECTED FROM THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS BY-LAW SHALL BE SHARED EQUALLY BETWEEN THE O'CHIESE AND SUNCHILD BANDS.
