

The Council of the Blood Band of Indians at a meeting held on the 1st day of October, 1963, make the following by-law pursuant to paragraphs (e), (q) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-Law No. 7.

A by-law to provide for the preservation, protection and management of game on the Blood Indian Reserve in the Province of Alberta.

1. In this by-law,

- (a) "Band" means the Blood Band of Indians;
- (b) "Council" means the Council of the Band;
- (c) "Guide" means any member of the Band licensed by the Council to guide for the purposes of this by-law;
- (d) "Permit" means a permit issued by the Superintendent, Blood Agency or Blood Band Secretary on behalf of the Council for the purpose of this by-law, and
- (e) "Reserve" means the Blood Indian Reserve.

2. No person other than a member of the Band shall hunt within the boundaries of the Reserve without a permit.

3. A permit shall entitle the person to whom it is issued to hunt ducks and geese only.

4. The Council may, from time to time, establish by resolution a fee for the issuing of permits.

5. No permit shall be issued to any person who is not the holder of a valid and subsisting Alberta Provincial hunting license.

6. The Council may cancel any permit, where, in the opinion of the Council, the holder of such permit has acted in the manner contrary to the best interests of the Band.

7. Open seasons, bag limits, possession limits and any other matters with respect to hunting not provided for in this by-law shall be with respect to ducks and geese as set out in the regulations for the Province of Alberta made under authority of the Migratory Birds Convention Act.
