

The Council of the TOBIQUE Band
of Indians at a meeting held at the Office of Chief
makes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (b)
and (r) of section 80 of The Indian Act.

Bylaw No. (14)

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of
traffic in TOBIQUE Indian Reserve, in
the Province of NEW BRUNSWICK.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of
speed in excess of 25 miles an hour within
any residential area designated and marked as
such by the council of the band.
- (b) Any person who violates any of the pro-
visions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an
offence and shall be liable on summary conviction
to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprison-
ment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both
fine and imprisonment.
