## **MUSQUEAM INDIAN BAND**

#### Musqueam Indian Band Capital Projects Fund Bylaw

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.I-5, the council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters rising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Musqueam Indian Band has duly and properly enacted the Musqueam Indian Band Property Taxation Bylaw (the "Taxation Bylaw");

AND WHEREAS section 12(3)(1) of the Taxation Bylaw authorizes expenditure from the capital projects fund for such capital projects as may be authorized by bylaw

NOW BE IT THEREBY RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of authorizing expenditures for capital projects and pursuant to section 12(3)(1) of the Taxation Bylaw.

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Musqueam Indian Band 2013 Capital Projects Bylaw.
- 2. The expenditures from the capital projects fund described in Schedule A attached to this Bylaw are hereby authorized.
