RATES BY-LAW 2013

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1) (a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. 1-5, the council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for the local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with repose to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band enacted the Kanaka Bar Indian Band Property Assessment and Taxation By-law on April 7, 1995;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) of the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1 This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Kanaka Bar Indian Band 2013 Rates bylaw.
- Pursuant to Section 30 of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band Property Taxation By-law, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2013 Rates By-law.

This by-law is hereby enacted by Council at a duly convened meeting held on the 15th day of August, 2013.
