HAISLA NATION RATES BY-LAW, 2013

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a Band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Haisla Nation enacted the *Haisla Nation* Property Assessment and Taxation By-law on July 25, 2006 and the Taxation Amendment By-law on August 23, 2007;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Haisla Nation Rates By-law 2013.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 11 of the *Haisla Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law*, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2013 Rates By-law.

THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council on the 27^{th} day of May 2013, at Kitamaat Village, in the Province of British Columbia.

Quorum for the Band Council is five Council Members and one Chief Councillor.
