AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO OSOYOOS INDIAN BAND PROPERTY ASSESSMENT LAW, 2009

Citation

1. This Law may be cited as *Amendment No. 1 to Osoyoos Indian Band Property Assessment Law, 2009*.

Replacement of Paragraph 22(1)(b)

2. Paragraph 22(1)(b) of the *Osoyoos Indian Band Property Assessment Law, 2009* is hereby deleted and substituted with the following:

“(b) the chair for his or her services at a rate of five hundred dollars (\$500) per day;”

Replacement of Subsection 29(2)

3. Subsection 29(2) of the *Osoyoos Indian Band Property Assessment Law, 2009* is hereby deleted and substituted with the following:


“(2) The address for delivery of a Notice of Appeal to the assessor is Suite 202 – 1500 Hardy Street, Kelowna, British Columbia, V1Y 8H2.”

Force and Effect


4. This Law comes into force and effect on the later of June 1, 2011 and the day after it is approved by the First Nations Tax Commission.

THIS LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council on the 13 day of MAY, 2011.

A quorum of Council consists of THREE (3) members of Council.


