1996 RATES BYLAW

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the Indian Act the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters rising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS The Council of the Whispering Pines/Clinton First Nation, (also known as the Whispering Pines/Clinton Band) enacted the Whispering Pines / Clinton First Nation Property Taxation Bylaw on December 8, 1995;

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act* and in particular section (83)(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Whispering Pines/Clinton Indian Band 1996 Rates Bylaw.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 11 of the Whispering Pines / Clinton Indian Band Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw No.1 (1995), the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 1996 Rates Bylaw.
