AND WHEREAS the Council of the Boston Bar First Nation enacted the Boston Bar First Nation Assessment and Taxation Bylaws (2004) on October 16, 2004, approved by the Minister December 20, 2004.

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following "Schedule A", enacted for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation, is hereby adopted and approved as the Boston Bar First Nation Tax Rates Bylaw 2011.
