DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

Bylaw No. 2007-T03
Little Shuswap First Nations Rates Bylaw

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the Indian Act the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interest in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of ancillary to such purpose;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Little Shuswap First Nation, (also known as the Little Shuswap Indian Band) enacted the Little Shuswap First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw on November 30, 1995 which includes the power to assess and levy property tax on railway right of way of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company pursuant to Regulations Amending The Property Assessment and Taxation (Railway Right-Of-Way) Regulations SOR/2003-373;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provision of the Indian Act and the Regulations SOR/2003-373 for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation of the Right-Of-Way of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company.

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Little Shuswap First Nation 2007 Railway Right-of-Way Tax Rates Bylaw.
2. The tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of this Bylaw.

This Bylaw is hereby enacted by the Council at a duly convened meeting held on the 23rd day of May, 2007.
