KAMLOOPS INDIAN BAND 1999 RATES AND BUDGET BYLAW

WHEREAS:

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The Kamloops Indian Band enacted the Taxation By-Law, the Assessment By-Law and the Taxation Expenditure Bylaw, duly approved by the Minister of Indian Affairs, pursuant to Section 83 of the *Indian Act*;

AND WHEREAS:

The Taxation Expenditure Bylaw provides for the Band Council to adopt an annual budget, including the projected revenues for the provision of local government services to the assessment area;

AND WHEREAS:

The Kamloops Indian Band wishes to establish the annual rates of taxation for the current tax year;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83 (1) thereof.

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Kamloops Indian Band 1999 Rates and Budget Bylaw.
- 2. Pursuant to section 7 of the Taxation Bylaw:
 - (a) the tax rates for each region and class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached to and forms part of this Bylaw;
 - (b) the levy in respect of the B.C. Assessment Authority shall be as set out in Schedule "B".
- 3. The budget set out in Schedule "C" shall be the budget for the provision of local government services to the assessment areas for the fiscal year 1999.
