**TSAWOUT INDIAN BAND
TAXATION AMENDING BY-LAW NO. 1996-1**

WHEREAS the Tsawout Indian Band passed the Tsawout Indian Band Taxation By-law which was duly approved by the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs pursuant to Section 83 of the Indian Act;

AND WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Tsawout Indian Band deem it advisable to amend the Tsawout Indian Band Taxation By-law in particular section 10 (2) , for the efficient operation of the taxation system.

1. Short Title

This By-law may be cited as the Tsawout Indian Band Taxation Amending ByLaw No. 1996-1.

2. Section 10 (2) of the Taxation By-law is amended by deleting it and substituting it by the following:

10 (2) If a portion of the taxes remain unpaid including unclaimed Home Owner Grants on the due date of the year they are first levied, there shall be added to them, as a penalty, 10% of the gross balance and that amount so added, shall be for all purposes be deemed part of the taxes.

The Taxation By-law is amended by adding section 33.1 (2) as follows:

33.1(2) A taxpayer claiming a home owner grant pursuant to section 33.1(1), may make application for such a grant prior to December 31 of the year in which the taxes were levied and providing that the taxes due by a tax payer are, or have been remitted in full. Home owner grants are not applicable to delinquent taxes, arrears, penalties or interest and are not transferable from one taxation year to the next.
