DO HEREBY RESOLVE ANNUAL TAX RATES BYLAW NO. 1, 1996 WHEREAS pursuant to the Nanaimo Indian Band Property Assessment & Taxation Bylaw it is necessary for Band Council during each taxation year to enact a bylaw establishing, imposing and levying the tax rate for each separate property class within each separate taxation district.

NOW THEREFORE the Band Council of the Nanaimo Indian Band enacts as follows:

- 1. Schedule "A" annexed hereto (in section 2 called the "Schedule") is hereby declared an integral part of this bylaw.
- 2. For the purposes of the Nanaimo Indian Band Property Assessment & Taxation Bylaw there are hereby imposed and levied for the taxation year 1996 the following tax rates, namely for each separate property class the tax rate set out in column 4 of the Schedule beside the property class set out in column 3 of the schedule.
- 3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Annual Tax Rates Bylaw No. 1, 1996.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and effect immediately upon approval of the Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development.
