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**THE CHIEF AND COUNCIL OF THE LOWER SIMILKAMEEN INDIAN BAND DO HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:**

**Lower Similkameen Indian Band  
2011 RATES BY-LAW  
BY-LAW NO. 01.2011**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C.1985, c. 1-5 the Council of the Band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of the land or interest in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve, and with respect to any matter arising out of or ancillary to such a purpose; with the *Lower Similkameen Indian Band Property Taxation By-law* it is necessary for Band Council during each taxation year to enact a By-law establishing, imposing and levying the tax for each separate property class within each separate taxation district;





**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Lower Similkameen Indian Band enacted the *Lower Similkameen Indian Band Property Assessment and Taxation By-law* on August 28, 2002;

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FOLLOWING** Bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the *Lower Similkameen Indian Band Tax Rates By-law No. 01.2011*
2. Pursuant to Section 11 of the *Lower Similkameen Indian Band Property Taxation By-law*, the tax rate for each class of property shall be in accordance with the rate schedule attached as Schedule "A", which forms part of the *Annual Tax Rates By-law No. 01.2011*.

THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Council at a duly convened meeting held on the 06 day of June, 2011.
