WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a Band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Kwaw Kwaw Apilt First Nation (also known, as the Kwaw Kwaw Apilt Indian Band) enacted the *Kwaw Kwaw Apilt First Nation Property Assessment Bylaw Amendment 1-1995* and the *Kwaw Kwaw Apilt First Nation Property Taxation Bylaw Amendment 1-1995* on December 08, 1995;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following Bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act* and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the **Kwaw Kwaw Apilt First Nation Rates Bylaw No. 2007**.
2. Pursuant to Section 3 of the *Kwaw Kwaw Apilt First Nation Property Assessment Bylaw Amendment 1-1995*, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with **Schedule "A-1"** which is attached, and forms part of the Kwaw Kwaw Apilt First Nation Rates Bylaw No. 2007.

This Bylaw is hereby made and approved at a duly convened meeting of the Chief and Council of the Kwaw Kwaw Apilt First Nation, also known as the Kwaw Kwaw Apilt Indian Band, this 23 day of May, 2007.
