WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the Indian Act, R.S.C. 1985, c.1-5, the Council of a Band may make by laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of fund, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Tzeachten First Nation (also known, as the Tzeachten Indian Band) enacted the Tzeachten First Nation Property Assessment Bylaw Amendment 1-1995 and the Tzeachten First Nation Property Taxation Bylaw Amendment 1-1995 on December 12, 1995;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following Bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Tzeachten First Nation Rates Bylaw No. 2004.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 3 of the Tzeachten First Nation Property Assessment Bylaw Amendment 1-1995, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A-1" which is attached, and forms part of the Tzeachten First Nation Rates Bylaw No. 2004.
