1997 Annual Tax Rates Bylaw

WHEREAS pursuant to section 18.1 of the Musqueam Indian Band Taxation Bylaw it is necessary for Band Council during each taxation year to enact a bylaw establishing, imposing and levying the tax rate for each separate property class within each separate taxation district.

NOW THEREFORE the Band council of the Musqueam Indian Band enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "A" annexed hereto (in section 2 called the "Schedule") is hereby declared an integral part of this bylaw.
2. For the purpose of subsections 18.1 (3) and (4) of the Musqueam Indian Band Property Taxation Bylaw, PR-96-02 there are hereby established, imposed and levied for the taxation year 1997 the following tax rates, namely for each separate property class within each separate taxation district the tax rates set out in column 4 of the Schedule beside the property class set out in column 3 of the Schedule.
3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the 1997 Annual Tax Rates bylaw.

4. This bylaw shall come into force and effect immediately upon approval by the Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development.

APPROVED AND PASSED at a duly convened meeting of the Band Council of the Musqueam Indian Band held at the Musqueam Indian Band Administration Office, Vancouver, British Columbia, as of this 26th day of May, 1997.
