DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the Indian Act R.S.C. 1985, c.1-5, the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Stoney First Nation enacted the Stoney Property Tax Bylaw on July 9, 1992;

NOW BE IT THEREBY RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Stoney First Nation 2004 Tax Rates Bylaw.
- 2. Pursuant to section 11 of the Stoney Property Tax Bylaw, the rate of tax applied against each \$1000 of the assessed value of property shall be:

a) for property other than machinery and

equipment or residential

c) for residential property

b) for machinery and equipment
