

## Whitefish Lake First Nation 1999 Tax Rates Bylaw

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.1-5, the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters rising out of or ancillary to such purpose; and


WHEREAS the Council of the Whitefish Lake First Nation enacted the Whitefish Lake First Nation Property Tax Bylaw on December 4, 1998;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act* and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Whitefish Lake First Nation 1999 Tax Rates Bylaw.
2. Pursuant to Section 5.1 of the Whitefish Lake Property Tax Bylaw, the rate of tax applied against the assessed value of property shall be,
  - (a) for property other than machinery and equipment 1.594%
  - (b) for machinery and equipment 0.625%

This bylaw is hereby enacted by Council at a duly convened meeting held on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 1999.
