RECITAL:

The Council of the Tsuu T'ina Nation therefore enacts the following By-Law:

SHORT TITLE: This By-Law by cited as Annual Budget By-Law 1993 (Tsuu T'ina Nation By-Law 2.6)

ANNUAL MILL RATE: The Mill Rate for the 1993 Taxation year is fixed at 57.59 Mills.

BUDGET AND **EXPENDITURE:**

The Funds raised by taxation shall be included as General Revenue and expended in accordance with the attached Budget.

QUORUM: There are Ten (10) Council Members and a Quorum consists of six (6) Members.
