BY-LAW NO. 01

FIRST NATION RATES BY-LAW

WHEREAS pursuant to the Indian Act, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the Indian Act, 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Upper Similkameen First Nation (also known as the Upper Similkameen Indian Band) enacted the Upper Similkameen First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law on July 15th, 2019;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Upper Similkameen First Nation Rates By-law 2019.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 22 of the Upper Similkameen First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2019 Rates By-law.

THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council on the 23rd day of September 2019, at Hedley, in the Province of British Columbia.
