BY-LAW NO. 01

FIRST NATION RATES BY-LAW

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Upper Similkameen First Nation (also known as the Upper Similkameen Indian Band) enacted the *Upper Similkameen Indian Band 2002 Property Taxation By-law*, and *Upper Similkameen Indian Band 2002 Property Assessment By-law* on December 13, 2002 and approved by the Minister on December 19, 2002;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the *Upper Similkameen First Nation Rates By-law 2021*.
2. Pursuant to Section 22 of the *Upper Similkameen Indian Band 2002 Property Taxation By-law*, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "II" which is attached, and forms part of the 2021 Rates By-law.

THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council on the 1st day of August 2021, at Hedley, in the Province of British Columbia.
