MICM#AS OF GESG#PEGIAG BYLAW TO REPEAL THE COVID-19 BYLAW

WHEREAS:

A Bylaw Concerning Preventive Measures Associated with the COVID 19 Epidemic/Pandemic 2021 (COVID-19 Bylaw) was enacted in response to the COVID-19 pandemic;

The COVID-19 pandemic evolves quickly and continuously, and the measures put in place to protect the health and safety of the members of the community must evolve in consequence;

The COVID Bylaw may be amended by vote of the Council at a duly convened meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council enacts as follows:

ARTICLE 1

A Bylaw Concerning Preventive Measures Associated with the COVID 19 Epidemic/Pandemic 2021 is repealed.

ARTICLE 2

This Bylaw to Repeal the COVID-19 Bylaw comes into force on the date of its publication in the First Nation Gazette.
