RATES BY-LAW 2025							
WHEREAS pursuant to the <i>Indian Act</i> , R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the <i>Indian Act</i> , 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;							
AND WHEREAS the Council of the Dene Tha' First Nation (also known as the Dene Tha' Band) enacted the <i>Dene Tha'</i> Property Assessment and Taxation By-law, on December 14, 1999 and approved by the Minister on February 28, 2000;							
NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the <i>Indian Act</i> , and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.							
1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Dene Tha' First Nation Rates By-law 2025.							
2. Pursuant to Section 17 of the <i>Dene Tha' Property Assessment and Taxation By-law</i> , the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2025 Rates By-law.
