TS'UUBAA-ASATX

PROPERTY TAXATION AMENDMENT LAW, 2019

WHEREAS:

A. Pursuant to section 5 of the *First Nations Fiscal Management Act*, the council of a first nation may make laws respecting taxation for local purposes of reserve lands and interests in reserve lands; and,

B. The Council of Ts'uubaa-asatx, formerly known as Lake Cowichan First Nation, wishes to amend the *Ts'uubaa-asatx Property Taxation Law, 2020* as set out in this amending law

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Ts'uubaa-asatx hereby enacts as follows

Citation

1. This Law may be cited as *Ts'uubaa-asatx Property Taxation Amendment Law, 2019*.

Replacement of Section 51

2. Section 51 of the *Ts'uubaa-asatx Property Taxation Law, 2020* is hereby deleted and substituted with the following:

“51. This Law comes into force and effect on December 28, 2019.”

Force and Effect

3. This Law comes into force and effect on the day after it is approved by the First Nations Tax Commission.


THIS LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council on the 14th day of November, 2019.
