DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

The Council of the Nipissing Band of Indians at a meeting held at Garden Village this Tenth Day of May, 1966, makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (h) and (m) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-Law No. 1

To establish a Community Centre at Garden Village comprised of a skating rink and to carry on a community program of Recreation within the regulations laid down by the Department of Education Act, Ontario.

A committee of 5 persons to be selected, 2 of which must be members of Council. This committee to have full jurisdiction over all recreation programs conducted on the reserve.

BY-LAW NO.!

A By-Law to establish a Community Centre at Garden Village

Whereas provision is made for the establishment of a Community Centre in Ontario under the Community Centres Act, 1961, and Whereas it is desired to establish a Community Centre

at Garden Village in the ^{District} township of Nipissing - Nipissing Indian Res.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Nipissing Board of the Nipissing Indian Res. enacts as follows:

That a Community Centre defined as Out-Door Rink (state if Swimming Pool, Athletic Field, Skating Arena, Out-Door Rink or Community Hall)

under the Community Centres Act 1961, and the regulations thereunder, and that the said Community Centre be administered by the following Board, duly appointed for the ensuing year.
