BY-LAW NO. 95 - 1

Being a by-law:

to repeal By-law No. 2 dated September 27, 1952 for the protection against and prevention of trespass by cattle and other domestic animals;

and to repeal by-law No. 5 dated July 6, 1960 to provide for the regulation of hawkers, pedlars, and others;

WHEREAS the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council did enact the two above recited by-laws;


AND WHEREAS the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council is of the opinion that such by-laws are not required at this time;


NOW THEREFORE, the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council enacts as a by-law the following:


1. By-law No. 2 dated September 27, 1952 for the protection against and prevention of trespass by cattle and other domestic animals is hereby repealed.
2. By-law No. 5 dated July 6, 1960 to provide for the regulation of hawkers, pedlars, and others is hereby repealed.


This by-law is hereby made at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte Band this 18th day of December, 1995.


