THAT, we enact as a by-law of the Big Cove Indian Band pursuant to Section 81 of the <u>Indian Act</u>, R.S.C., C. I-5, the following:

FIRST NATIONS LAW NO.

THE MI'KMAQ FIRST NATION AT BIG COVE

WHEREAS paragraphs (c), (d), (h) and (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act empower the Council of a Band to make by-laws respecting the observance of law and order, the prevention of disorderly conduct and nuisances, and the regulation of the use of buildings owned by the Band, respectively, and the imposition of penalties for violations thereof;

NOW THERFORE, the Council of the Big Cove Indian Band enacts as a by-law the following:

A FIRST NATIONS LAW TO PREVENT PETTY TRESPASSES AND LOITERING IN PUBLIC PLACES ON THE BIG COVE RESERVE.

1. In this by-law:

"authorized person" means an occupier or possessor of premises;

"loiter" means to hang idly about a place;

"occupier" means

- (a) a person who is in possession or control of premises; and
- (b) school personnel including teachers, chief administrative officers and other administrative personnel, school building maintenance personnel, secretaries, persons other than teachers engaged to deliver or to assist in

"public place" means any place to which the public have access as of right or by invitation, express or implied, and includes

- the Big Cove Band Administration Building; and (a)
- other buildings owned by the Band and used for public (b) purposes.

"trespass" means entering or remaining without lawful authority on premises or land, occupied, possessed or controlled by another.

- No person shall trespass on: 2.(1)
 - (a) the premises of a shop, store, shopping mall or shopping plaza; OR
 - the premises of a school, vocational school, (b) training institute or other premises used for educational purposes;

with respect to which he has notice from an authorized person not to trespass.

For the purposes of subsection (1), a person has notice 2.(2) not to trespass when he has been given notice by word or mouth or in writing to refrain from entering or from remaining on the premises and the notice shall be deemed

 - for a second or subsequent offence in relation to the (b) same premises or public place to a fine of not less than one hundred dollars and not more than one thousand dollars and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days.
