THE EEL GROUND BAND OF INDIANS

The Council of the Eel Ground Band of Indians at a meeting held 18 day of July, 1973, makes the following By-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of section 80 of The Indian Act.

BY-LAW # 5

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Eel Ground Indian Reserve, in the Province of New Brunswick.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 30 miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the council of the band.
- (b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
