

The Council of the Walpole Island Amalgamated Band of Indians at a meeting held this Tenth day of September 1962, make the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and paragraph (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

" By-Law No. 7

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Walpole Island No. 46 Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario.

1. In this by-law
 - (a) "Council" means the Council of the Walpole Island Amalgamated Band of Indians;
 - (b) "Reserve" means the Walpole Island No. 46 Indian Reserve; and
 - (c) "restricted zone" means any area in the Reserve designated in writing by the Council as a restricted zone for the purposes of this by-law.
2. No vehicle shall be operated within the Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of 45 miles an hour.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 hereof, no vehicle shall be operated in a restricted zone at a rate of speed in excess of 25 miles an hour.
4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
