

WHITEFISH RIVER INDIAN RESERVE NO. 4

BY-LAW NO. 3

TRAFFIC SPEED

The Council of the Whitefish River Band of Indians at a meeting held this 24th day of July A.D. 1980 made the following by-law pursuant to Section 6 of the Regulations Governing the Operation of Vehicles Within Reserves.

1. That no vehicle be operated on the Reserve at a greater rate of speed than 50 kilometres per hour (miles per hour) unless otherwise posted.
2. No Vehicle shall be operated on the Reserves at a greater rate of speed than 30 kilometres per hour (miles per hour) in a built-up area.
3. That the schedules of fines and penalties be the same as set out in the Provincial Statute Highway Traffic Act of Ontario, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 202.
4. That the definition sections of the Highway Traffic Act apply with the exception of those definitions already set out in the Regulations Governing the Operation of Vehicles within Indian Reserves.
