A BY-LAW TO CREATE A BEAR ISLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT

The council at the Bear Island Indian Reserve assembled enacts the Bear Island Police be responsible for the following function

1. Enforcement of Band By-laws
2. Enforcement of truancy regulations and curfews
3. Enforcement of all provincial and federal statutes on reserve
4. Liaison with O.P.P. and R.C.M.P. Police
5. Fire Prevention and co-ordination of volunteer fire department
6. Emergency co-ordination and planning

The Bear Island Police shall be responsible to a Police Committee created by the Bear Island Reserve Council. The Police Committee Chairman shall be a member of council and shall be appointed by Council.

The Police Committee shall comprise of six local residents of the reserve and any other consultants that the Bear Island Band Council deems advisable for the good of the operation of the Committee. The Police Committee Chairman and the Chief Constable shall be responsible for the administration, training, and supervision of the Band Constables

The Bear Island Police shall be a separate Indian Municipal Police Force and shall be considered a Municipal Police Force for the purposes of policing

This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of the final passing by Council
