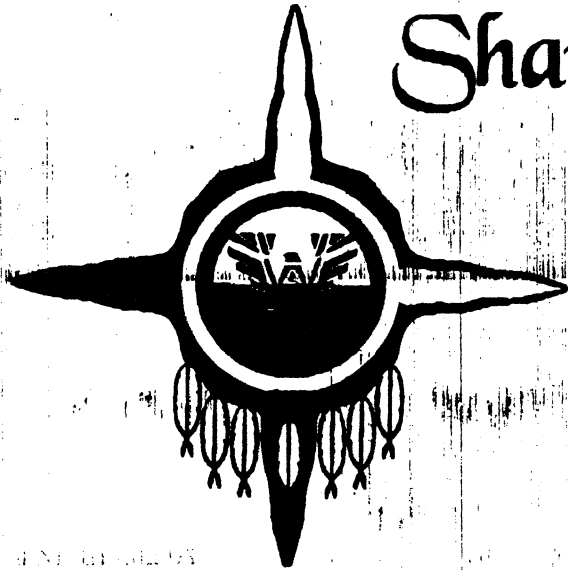

A QUORUM FOR THIS GOVERNMENT

DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

WHEREAS Shawanaga First Nation By-Law No. 17:176, Registration No. SOR/76/569, provides for the regulation of traffic, law and order, local works, trespassing, and penalty.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Shawanaga First Nation did enact By-Law No. 17:176 on the 7th day of September, 1976.

AND WHEREAS the Government of Shawanaga deems it to be expedient and in the best interests of the residents of Shawanaga First Nation to amend the said by-law.

NOW THEREFORE Section 5.2 (a) of By-Law No. 17:176 is amended by striking out the words "twenty five (25) kilometres an hour" where they appear therein and substituting therefor the words "forty (40) kilometres an hour", so that Section 5.2 (a) now reads:

5.2 No person shall operate a vehicle on Shawanaga First Nation Road in Shawanaga Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of:

a) forty (40) kilometres an hour in the Village Core Area, as shown on the map in Schedule A, attached; or

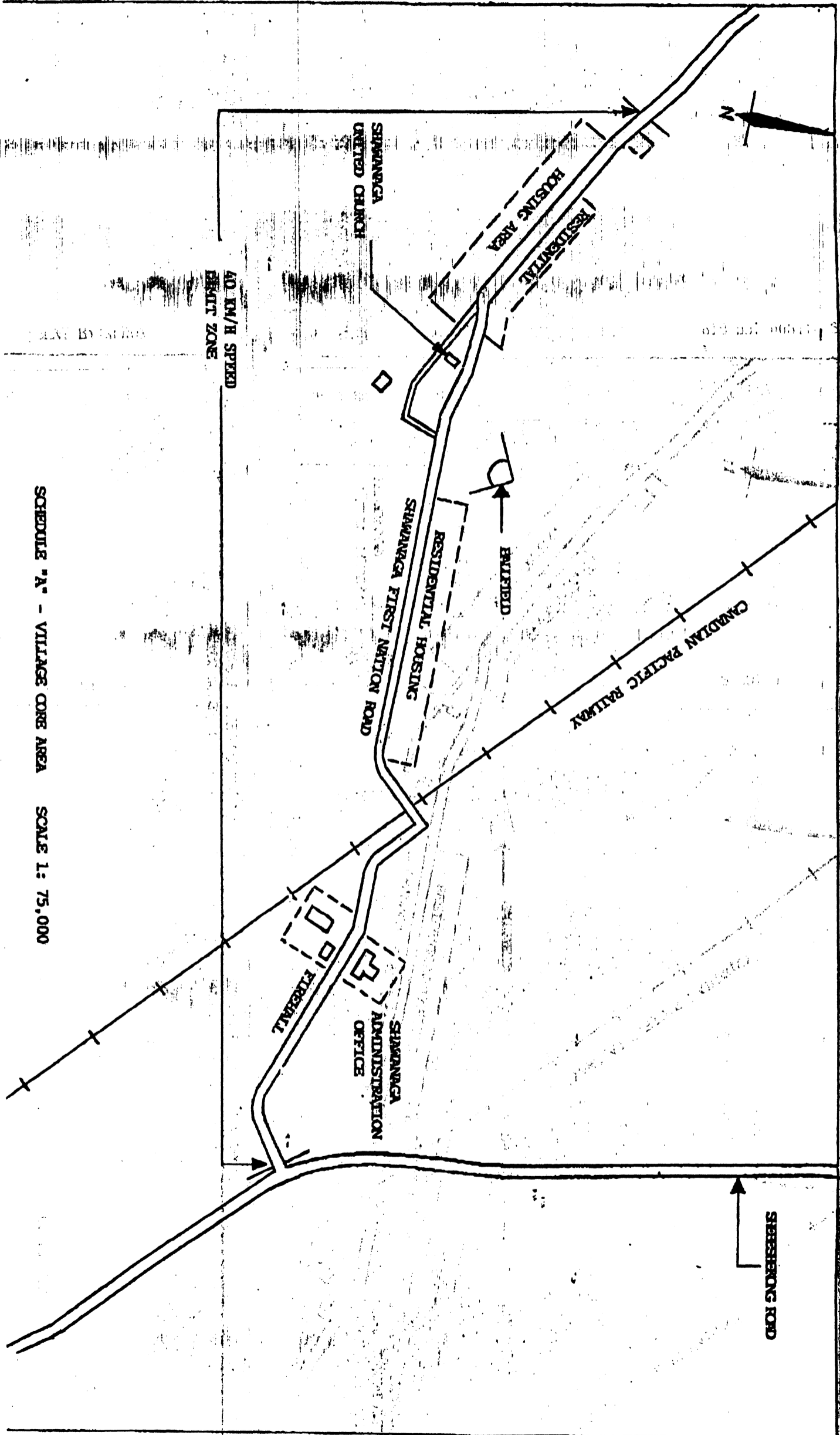
