

- BY-LAW - Number 26 -

A By-Law regulating the use of the Sauble Beach Park, Saugeen Indian Reserve No. 29, pursuant to paragraphs (b), (c), (d), (e), (m), (p), (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act R.S.c 149, s1.

This by-law will supersede any previous related by-law pertaining to the Sauble Beach Park.

1. In this by-law:-

- (a) "All terrain vehcile" means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven,
 - (i) exclusively on snow or ice, or both or
 - (ii) on land or water or nav like vehicle. but does not include an automobile.
- (b) "Domestic animal" means a horse, a dog or anv other animal that is kept under human control or bv habit or training lives in association with man:
- (c) "Highway" means a highway as defined in the Ontario Highway Traffic Act:
- (d) "Motorcycle" means anv variety of 2-wheeled motor vehicle including motor-cvcles. mopeds. scooters. or anv similiar tvpe vehicle:
- (e) "Motor Vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined in the Ontario Highway Traffic act:
- (f) "Officer" means anv member of the Saugeen Police or anv person designed enforce this bv-law by the Saugeen Band Council:
- (g) "Peak Season" means the period of time beginning on the sixteenth dav of May and ending on Labour Dav of the same year:
- (h) "Roadwav" means any roadway, street, lane, driveway, or other place open for the passage of vehicles;
- (i) "Sauble Beach Park" means all lands west of lot 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 of Reserve, Plan Number 50167 and to the Southern Point of Lot 11, Reserve Plan Number 51937 and 50167 of the Saugeen Indian Reserve Number 29;
- (j) "Vehicle" means any wagon, cart, motor, car, motor truck, trailer, motor-cycle, traction engine, road making machinery or any other conveyance that is driven propelled or drawn by an power.
- (k)

2. No person shall:

- (a) Remove, damage, or deface any property of the Saugeen Band Council within the Sauble Beach Park.
- (b) Impede traffic or emergency vehicle for any reason - re:- trenches or other construction on the Sauble Beach Park.

3. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any litter in the Sauble Beach Park, except in a place designated for that purpose.
4. Every person to whom a vehicle permit has been issued shall, upon the request of an officer, produce the permit for inspection by the officer.
5. (1) No person, being the owner or person in control of a domestic animal shall;
 - (a) permit a domestic animal to be at large in Sauble Beach Park;
 - (b) permit a domestic animal to be in any waters in Sauble Beach Park designated as swimming areas, or upon any part of the beach adjacent thereto.
- (2) No person shall permit a domestic animal to make excessive noise or disturb other persons in Sauble Beach Park.
- (3) A domestic animal shall be deemed to be at large unless such animal is secured on a leash that does not exceed two meter in length.
- (4) An officer may seize and impound or cause to be seized or impounded a domestic animal where the owner or person in control of such animal is in contravention of subsection (1) or subsection (2) of this section.
- (5) Where an officer seizes or impounds an animal under subsection (4) the officer may make such remedy as he may deem necessary under the circumstances and the owner or person in control of such animal shall be responsible for any costs incurred.
6. No person shall:
 - (a) start or have a fire except as permitted by the Saugeen Band Council
or;
 - (b) possess or ignite fireworks, within the Sauble Beach Park.
7. (1) No person shall use abusive or insulting language or make excessive noise or disturb other persons within the Sauble Beach Park.
- (2) Where an officer believes on reasonable and propable grounds that a person has contravened subsection (1) of this Section or is found to be in violation of any section of this by-law or any Provincial or Federal Statute in force within the Sauble Beach park, the officer may remove or cause to be removed the person from the Sauble Beach Park and may cancel any vehicle permit of the person pertaining to the Sauble Beach Park.
8. No person shall camp overnight in Sauble Beach Park except under the authority of the Saugeen Band Council.
9. (1) No person except those designated by Saugeen Band Council shall take a motor vehicle into Sauble Beach Park except under a vehicle permit issued by the Saugeen Band Council.

- (2) A vehicle permit expires at the posted hours of closing for the Sauble Beach Park on the day of which it is issued;
 - (3) The fee for daily vehicle permits shall be established by the Saugeen Band Council.
 - (4) Where an officer believes on reasonable and probable grounds that a motor vehicle is in Sauble Beach Park in contravention of subsection (1) or subsection (2) of this Section he may remove or cause to be removed any such motor vehicle and the cost of such removal and any subsequent costs shall be the responsibility of the owner of the motor vehicle.
10. No person shall sell or offer for sale any article, thing or service within Sauble Beach Park without the express permission of the Saugeen Band Council.
 11. No person other than those designated by the Saugeen Band Council shall operate a motorcycle or all terrain vehicle in Sauble Beach Park within peak season.
 12. (1) No person shall park a vehicle within Sauble Beach Park.
 - (i) in a position or place that prevents or is likely to prevent free and convenient movement of other vehicles.
 - or
 - (ii) in any prohibited area.
 13. (1) An officer or person appointed by an officer may direct any pedestrian or vehicular traffic and in case of fire, accident, traffic congestion or other emergency, may direct it into such channels as are necessary to prevent or relieve congestion or give right of way.
 - (2) Every person shall obey and direction given under subsection (1).
 14. No person shall drive any vehicle in Sauble Beach Park at a rate of speed exceeding 25 km/hr.
 15. The driver of any vehicle shall comply with all laws and regulations which would ordinarily be in force from time to time in the province in which the Sauble Beach Park is situated as relates to vehicles, except such laws that are inconsistent with this by-law.
 16. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days or both.

- BY-LAW - Number 26 -

A By-Law to regulating the use of Sauble Beach Park, Saugeen Indian Reserve No. 29, pursuant to paragraphs (b), (c), (d), (e), (m), (p), (q), (r), of Section 81 of the Indian Act R.S., c. 149, si.

This by-law will supersede any previous by-law pertaining to the Sauble Beach Park.

1. In this by-law:-

- (a) "All terrain vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven,
 - (i) exclusively on snow or ice, or both, or
 - (ii) on land or water
 or any like vehicle, but does not include an automobile.
- (b) "Domestic animal" means a horse, a dog or any other animal that is kept under human control or by habit or training lives in association with man;
- (c) "Highway" means a highway as defined in the Ontario Highway Traffic Act;
- (d) "Motorcycle" means any variety of 2-wheeled motor vehicle including motorcycles, mopeds, scooters or any similar type vehicle;
- (e) "Motor Vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined in the Ontario Highway Traffic Act;
- (f) "Officer" means any members of the Saugeen Police or any person designated enforce this by-law by the Saugeen Band Council.
- (g) "Peak Season" means the period of time beginning on the sixteenth day of May and ending on Labour Day of the same year;
- (h) "Roadway" means any roadway, street, lane, driveway, or other place open for the passage of vehicle;
- (i) "Sauble Beach Park" means all lands west of Lot 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, of Reserve, Plan Number 50167 of the Saugeen Indian Reserve Number 29.
- (j) "Vehicle" means any wagon, cart, motor, car, motor truck, trailer, motorcycle, traction engine, road making machinery or any other conveyance that is driven propelled or drawn by an power.

2. No person shall:-

- (a) Remove, damage or deface any property of the Saugeen Band Council within the Sauble Beach Park.
- (b) Impede traffic or emergency vehicle for any reason - re: trenches or other construction on the Sauble Beach Park.

3. No other person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any litter in the Sauble Beach Park, except in a place designated for the purpose.

4. Every person to whom a vehicle permit has been issued shall, upon the request of an officer, produce the permit for inspection by the officer.

5. (1) No person, being the owner or person in control of a domestic animal shall;
 - (a) permit a domestic animal to be at large in Sauble Beach Park;
 - (b) permit a domestic animal to be in any waters in Sauble Beach Park designated as swimming areas, or upon any part of the beach adjacent thereto.
 - (2) No person shall permit a domestic animal to make excessive noise or disturb other persons in Sauble Beach Park.
 - (3) A domestic animal shall be deemed to be at large unless such animal is secured on a leash that does not exceed two meters in length.
 - (4) An officer may seize and impound or cause to be seized or impounded a domestic animal where the owner or person in control of such animal is in contravention of subsection (1) or subsection (2) of this section.
 - (5) Where an officer seizes or impounds an animal under subsection (4) the officer may make such remedy as he may deem necessary under the circumstances and the owner or person in control of such animal shall be responsible for any costs incurred.
6. No person shall:-
- (a) start or have a fire except as permitted by the Saugeen Band Council or;
 - (b) possess or ignite fireworks, within Sauble Beach Park.
7. (1) No person, shall use abusive or insulting language or make excessive noise or disturb other persons within the Sauble Beach Park.
 - (2) Where an officer believes on reasonable and probable grounds that a person has contravened subsection (1) of this section or is found to be in violation of any section of this by-law or any Provincial or Federal Statute in force within the Sauble Beach Park, the officer may remove or cause to be removed the person from the Sauble Beach Park and may cancel any vehicle permit of the person pertaining to the Sauble Beach Park.
8. No person shall camp overnight in Sauble Beach Park except under the authority of the Saugeen Band Council.
9. (1) No person except those designated by the Saugeen Band Council shall take a motor vehicle into Sauble Beach Park except under a vehicle permit issued by the Saugeen Band Council;
 - (2) A vehicle permit expires at the posted hours of closing for the Sauble Beach Park on the day of which it is issued;
 - (3) The fee for daily vehicle permits shall be established by the Saugeen Band Council;
 - (4) Where an officer believes on reasonable and probable grounds that a motor vehicle is in Sauble Beach Park in contravention of subsection (1) or subsection (2) of this Section he may remove or cause to be removed any such motor vehicle and the cost of such removal and any subsequent costs shall be the responsibility of the owner of the motor vehicle.
10. No person shall sell or offer for sale any article, thing or service within Sauble Beach Park without the express permission of the Saugeen Band Council.

- 11. No person other than those designated by the Saugeen Band Council shall operate a motorcycle or all terrain vehicles in Sauble Beach Park within peak season.
- 12. (1) No person shall park a vehicle within Sauble Beach Park.
 - (a) in a position or place that prevents or is likely to prevent free convenient movement of other vehicles, or
 - (b) in any prohibited area.
- 13. (1) An officer or person appointed by an officer may direct any pedestrian or vehicular traffic and in a case of fire, accident, traffic congestion or other emergency, may direct it into such channels as are necessary to prevent or relieve congestion or give right of way;
- 14. No person shall drive any vehicle in Sauble Beach Park at a rate of speed exceeding 25 km/hr.
- 15. The driver of any vehicle shall comply with all laws and regulations which would ordinarily be in force from time to time in the province in which the Sauble Beach Park is situated as relates to vehicles, except such laws that are inconsistent with this by-law.
- 16. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days or both.
