BY-LAW NUMBER 21

- (1) A By-Law to control two (2) wheeled motor vehicles, motorcycles, mopeds, scooters etc. in the Sauble Beach Park.
- (2) In this By-Law
 "Band" shall mean the Saugeen Band of Indians.
 "Band Council" shall mean the Saugeen Indian Reserve number 29 Band Council.
 "Reserves" shall mean the Saugeen Indian Reserve number twenty-nine (29), the Chief's Point Indian Reserve number twenty-eight (28), the Saugeen Hunting Grounds number sixty (60), the Fishing Islands.
- (3) "Park" shall mean all the lands west of Lots 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 Reserve plan number 50167 and to the southern point of Lot 1, plan number 51937, Reserve plan number 50167 on the Saugeen Indian Reserve number 29.
 "two (2) wheeled motor vehicle" shall mean motorcycles, mo-peds, scooters etc.
- (4) No motor vehicle in the class of motorcycles, mo-peds, scooters, etc., shall use the Saugeen Reserve, South Sauble Beach Park during the months of June, July and August in any given year.
- (5) Any person violating this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, upon summary conviction, to a penalty of not less than one (1) dollar and not more than Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months, or both fine and imprisonment.

Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Saugeen Band of Indians this twentieth day of May, 1976.
