BY-LAW NO. 1995.01  
OF THE MISSISSAUGAS OF THE NEW CREDIT FIRST NATION  
BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1992.01,  
A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT INTOXICANTS

WHEREAS subsection 85.1(1) of the Indian Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. I-5, as amended, authorizes the Council of a First Nation to make by-laws:

- (a) prohibiting the sale, barter, supply or manufacture of intoxicants on the reserve;
- (b) prohibiting any person from being intoxicated on the reserve;
- (c) prohibiting any person from having intoxicants in his possession on the reserve; and
- (d) providing for exceptions to any of the prohibitions established pursuant to paragraph (b) or (c);

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of section 85.1 of the Indian Act, the Council of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation did enact by-law number 1992.01, being a by-law declaring and intended to effect a prohibition against the sale, barter or supply of intoxicants on the Reserve of the First Nation, subject to certain exceptions;

AND WHEREAS, subsection 85.1(4) (a) of the Indian Act provides that every person who contravenes a by-law made under this section is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction, in the case of a by-law made under paragraph 85.1(1) (a), to a fine of not more than one thousand dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or both;

AND WHEREAS, a majority of the electors of the First Nation who attended a special meeting of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation on May 02, 1992, called by the Council of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation on April 13, 1992 for the purpose of considering the contents of what was enacted as by-law number 1992.01;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation deems it expedient, in the best interest of the residents of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation reserve and is desirous to amend the said by-law number 1992.01 as provided for herein;

AND WHEREAS, a majority of the electors of the First Nation who attended a special meeting of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation on November 06, 1995, called by the Council of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation on October 23, 1995 for the purpose of considering the proposed amendments to the said by-law number 1992.01 and the contents of this amending by-law, assented to the amendments proposed and the contents of this amending by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation enacts as a by-law thereof, pursuant to section 85.1 of the Indian Act, the following by-law to amend by-law number 1992.01 as follows:


1. The definition of "supply" contained in section 2 INTERPRETATION of by-law No. 1992.01 is hereby amended by adding thereto the words, "or barter, except where the intoxicant is used or intended to be used solely by a person in his/her home or private dwelling to which he/she has been invited; so that the amended definition of "supply" contained in the said Section 2 shall read as follows:

"Supply" means to serve, furnish or deliver otherwise than by sale or barter, except where the intoxicant is used or intended to be used solely by a person in his/her home or private dwelling to which he/she has been invited;

Section 4, EXCEPTIONS of by-law No. 1992.01 is hereby amended by deleting in whole the said Section 4, including subsection 4(a).
