DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

The Council of the Hiawatha Band of Indians at a meeting held on the Hiawatha Reserve makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 2

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in Hiawatha Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 30 miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
