FORT WILLIAM BAND OF INDIANS

BY-LAW NO.

Being a By-law respecting the control of dogs.

WHEREAS the Council of the Fort William Band of Indians did enact their By-law Number 15 dated the 23rd day of March, 1970, respecting the control of dogs on the Reserve;

AND WHEREAS the Council deem it to be expedient and in the best interest of the residents of the Fort William Reserve to bring into effect on the Reserve the <u>Indian Reserve Dog Regulations</u> as made under Section 72 of the <u>Indian Act</u> in lieu of the said By-law Number 15;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Fort William Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof the following:

- 1. By-law Number 15 passed by the Council of the Fort William Band of Indians on the 23rd day of March, 1970, be and the same is hereby repealed.
- 2. That the Indian Reserve Dog Regulations as provided for under Section 72 of the Indian Act be brought into effect.
