

EAGLE LAKE BAND

BY-LAW NO. 6-84

- (1) This By-law may be cited as The Construction By-law.
- (2) This By-law is made pursuant to paragraph (h) and (r) of section 81 of the Indian Act.
- (3) In this By-law:
  - (1) "Building" means any structure erected by the Band or by an individual member for the purpose of a dwelling, store or shed.
  - (2) "Occupied land" means
    - (1) Any parcel of land that is held under lease or rent.
    - (11) Lots set aside by the Council for band projects or
    - (111) Any land that is used by an individual Band Member.
- (4) No person shall construct or attempt to construct a building on any occupied land without the occupants written permission.
- (5) No building shall be erected within the boundaries of the Eagle Lake Indian Reserve without proper planning and in consultation with the Council of the Band.
- (6) No person shall repair to use or attempt to repair in use a vacant house without the written consent of the owner and in construction with the Band Council.
- (7) Violators of this By-law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable on Summary Conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or to imprisonment not exceeding 30 days or to both fine and imprisonment.
- (8) This By-law was approved and passed at a meeting of the Band Council on June 14, 1984.
